The primary focus of the CCS is the safety and well-being of children and young people. The program maintains a clear commitment to prioritising the needs and welfare of children and will actively intervene to ensure that the best interests of children are protected and promoted at all times. The CCS provides safe neutral, onsite facilitated changeovers and supervised visits for children and their separated parents with a trauma-informed and child-focused approach. These contacts are often court mandated due to high conflict familial circumstances and often exist within a broader suite of family law services.			
The Services delivered by the CCS occur primarily over the weekend with some service delivery occurring during the week.			
This position exists to serve as a facilitator and observer of clients during scheduled visitation. As part of this, there will be a requirement to greet clients, support their participation in the service and document observations during the provision of service. The role is casual (on a needs only basis) and will include weekday and Saturday engagements.
